



# Tour de Cricket '22

## JOIN US ON A UNIQUE CYCLING ADVENTURE

Last year's incredible [Palaces on Wheels](#) (click here) ride started at Highgrove with HRH The Prince of Wales leading 30 cyclists out on a bike. The ride finished four days and 400km later at Balmoral Castle with stops at Windsor Castle, St James Palace and Buckingham Palace along the way. The challenge raised almost half a million pounds to help vulnerable people in South Asia.

Our cycle challenge is back again this year! We're looking for another 30 riders that want to #HaveFun #GetFit #MakeADifference and join us for Tour de Cricket '22, a 350km four day cycling adventure as we visit iconic locations and cricket grounds across the UK with some incredible surprises planned for the riders along the way.

The Tour de Cricket '22 starts on Thursday 8 September in Somerset (registration and welcome dinner on 7 September) and finishes at lunchtime on 11 September in London.

You'll cycle an average of 80km daily over four days, with scenic routes taking you past landmarks such as Longleat House, Stonehenge and Salisbury Cathedral, as well as visiting some world famous cricket grounds.

The ride is challenging enough to provide a rewarding experience, but suitable for all levels of riders. Each evening you'll have an opportunity to relax over dinner and enjoy the comradery of other riders and some of our closest supporters.

## ITINERARY

### 7 SEPT, ARRIVAL & REGISTRATION

(3pm onwards) The group will meet at Dillington House, Ilminster, the night before the ride for a three-course meal in a private dining area and a briefing ahead of the challenge

### 8 SEPT, DAY 1 RIDE

The challenge will start from Somerset County Cricket Club in Taunton, travelling to Longleat House and finishing in Warminster at end of the day

### 9 SEPT, DAY 2 RIDE

A scenic day of cycling from Warminster to Stonehenge, on to Salisbury Cathedral and finishing at The Ageas Bowl in Southampton

### 10 SEPT, DAY 3 RIDE

The route will take you from Southampton through the Surrey Hills, an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, ending in Guildford

### 11 SEPT, DAY 4 RIDE

On the final day, participants will cycle to The Oval and Lord's Cricket Ground in London
